


Purpose of this Data Update

 - How many districts are receiving temporary waivers of the implementation of the 24-credit graduation requirements?




Which Method are Districts Using to Calculate Instructional Hours for the Class of 2016?






2016 District Graduation Requirements Compared to the 24-Credit Graduation Framework




High School Districts Already Requiring a Third Credit of Science for the Class of 2015







Districts Requiring Other Credit for the Class of 2016




What Proportion of Districts Require the High School and Beyond Plan for Credit?



Districts Offering Competency-Based Crediting for the Class of 2016




Of the Districts Offering Competency-Based Crediting for the Class of 2016, How Many Allow World Language?



Number of High School Districts Receiving Temporary Waiver of 24-Credit Graduation Requirements






Total Enrollment of High School Districts Receiving Temporary Waiver of 24-Credit Graduation Requirements
