<b>Comprehensive</b>	Current Priority Definition	Required by federal law to be the lowest performing 5% of schools. Graduation rate less than 67%.	Link to <a href="#">definitions</a> . The methodology to get to the comprehensive set of schools will be a norm-referenced approach.
<b>Targeted</b>	Current Focused Definition	Required by federal law to be any school with one or more consistently underperforming subgroups.	The methodology to get to a targeted set of schools will be a criterion-referenced approach.
<b>Weighting</b>			The weighting aligns to federal requirements. Different permutations are resulting in similar identification scenarios.

<b>Display</b>	Achievement index and report card are currently static displays and not connected/linked to one another.	Dynamic display of an integrated achievement index and report card with both big "A" and little "a" accountability measures.	Funding was provided in the budget to update the school report card site inclusive of a dynamic display of index.
