CHARTER SCHOOL CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE RCW 28A.710.150

Pursuant to RCW 28A.710.150(2), the Washington State Board of Education is required to certify that an Authorizer approved public charter school meets the limits for establishing new charter schools set forth in RCW 28A.710.150(1). This certification is required to be done before final authorization of the charter school.

On January 30, 2014, the Washington Charter School Commission approved First Place Scholars as a Washington State Charter School for opening in the 2014-15 school year. The Commission submitted a timely report of the action taken to the SBE on February 4, 2014 as required by RCW 28A.710.150(2).

The State Board of Education, as required by RCW 28A.710.150(2) and under the process prescribed in RCW 28A.710.150(3) and WAC 180-19-090, now certifies that the Washington Charter School Commission's approval of First Place Scholars as a Public Charter School for opening in 2014 is in compliance with the limits on the maximum number of charters allowed under RCW 28A.710.150(1).
