#### Considerations:

 How to handle focus schools is not necessarily linked to a 6<sup>th</sup> tier option.

- Asking for motion of the Board Goal is to 'turn the page' from policy design to technical vetting and federal approval process.
  - Adopt this Index redesign as provisional Index, including any modifications made today (ELL, etc).
  - Direct process of technical vetting, including opportunity for districts to see their data before stakes are attached.
  - Direct staff to submit design to federal US Dept. of Ed for their consideration. Initiate iterative approval process.
  - Specify in submission that SBE anticipates modifications, either as a result of technical testing or, more likely, the transition to Common Core.
  - We are in a time of transition.
