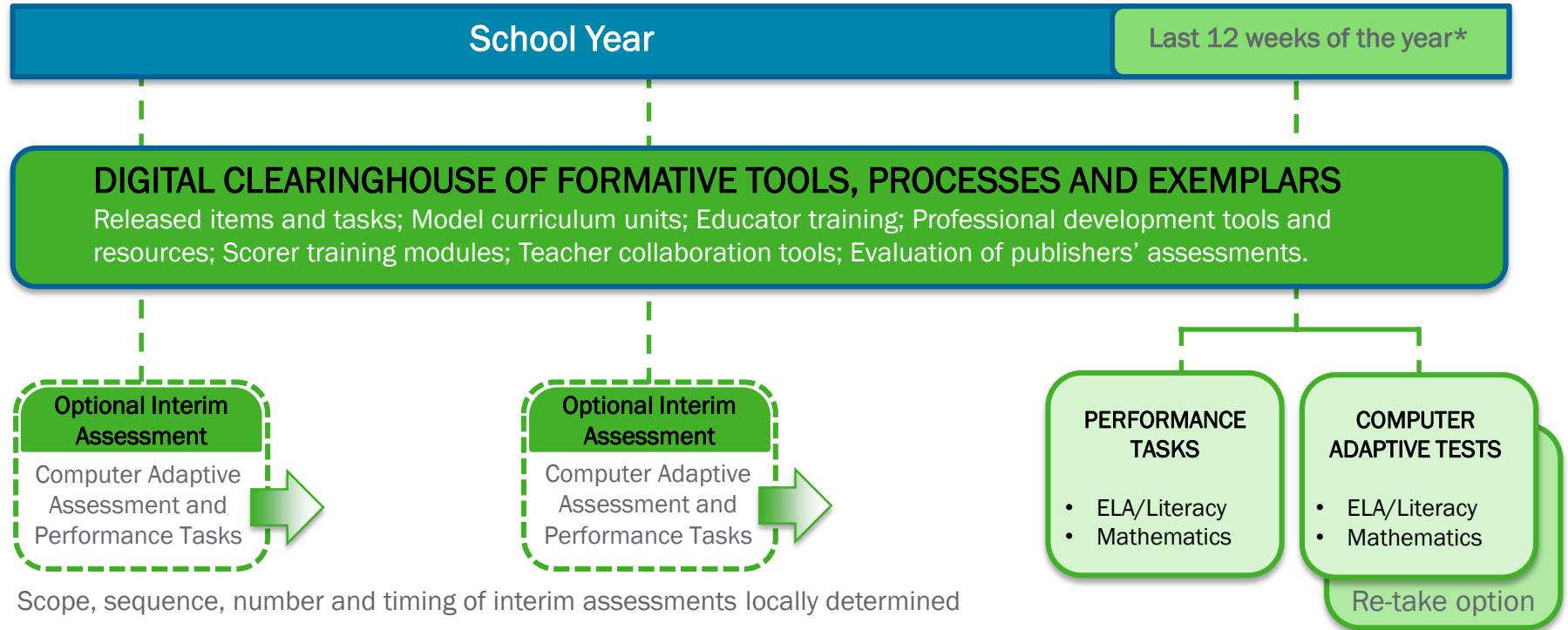

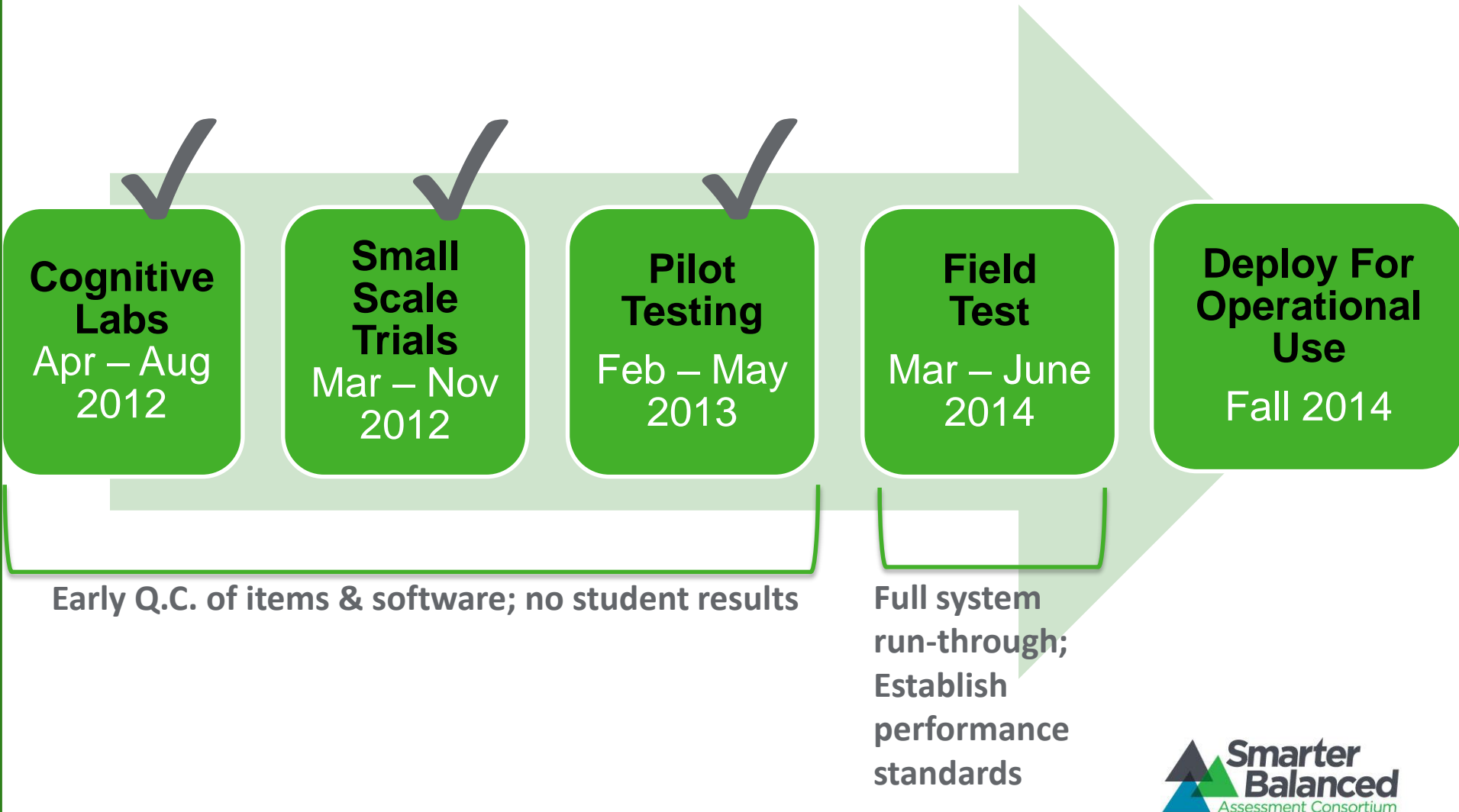
A BALANCED ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

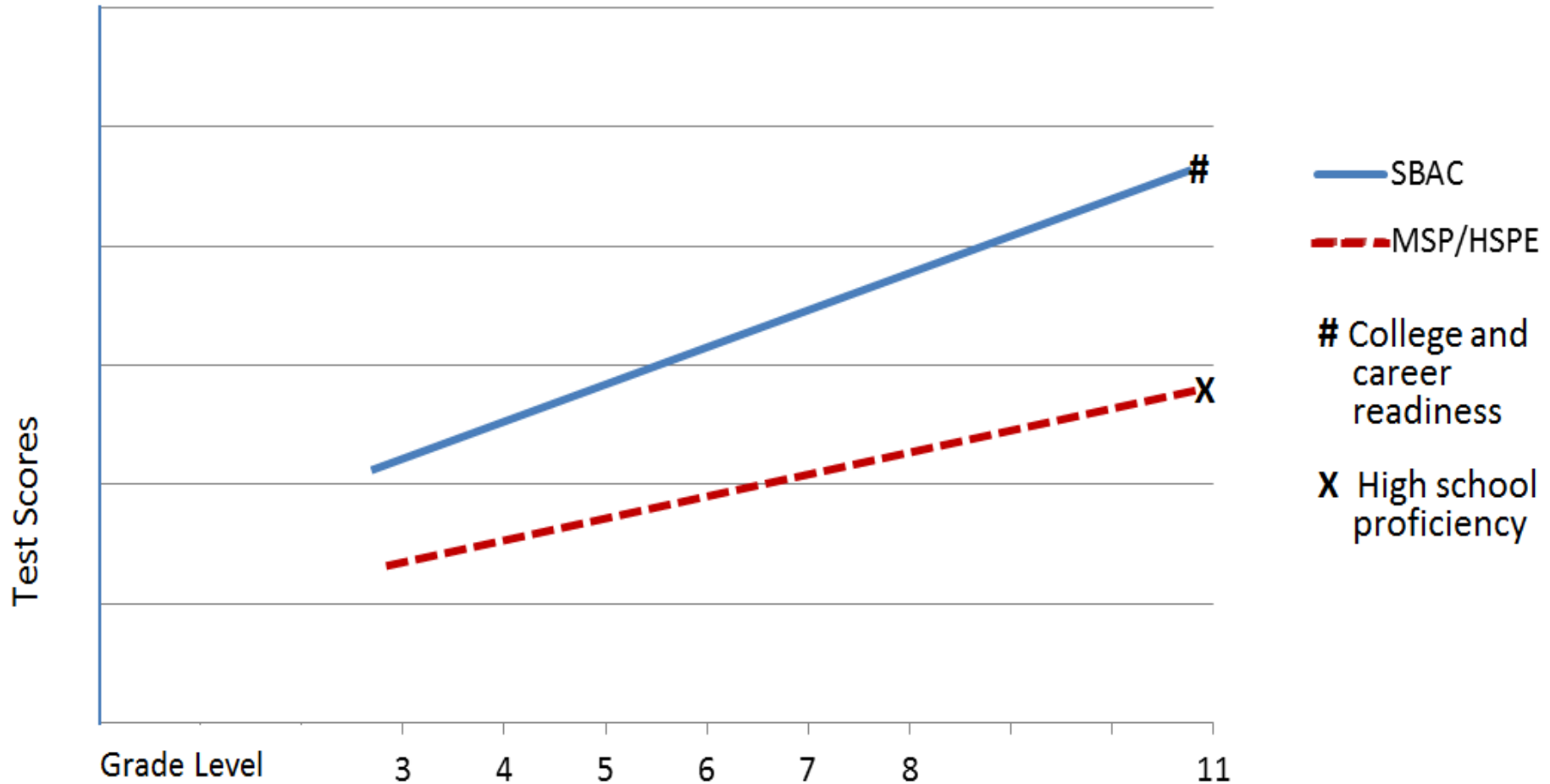

Graduation Assessment Requirements

- Classes of 2013 and 2014
 - HSPE Reading, HSPE Writing; 1 EOC Math
- Classes of 2015 – 2018
 - ELA exit exam; 1 EOC Math exit exam; EOC Biology
 - Smarter Balanced ELA and math tests taken in 11th for school accountability
- Class of 2019 and beyond
 - Smarter Balanced tests in ELA and Math; Biology or NGSS

RESHAPING COLLEGE TRANSITION

(COMMUNITY COLLEGE RESEARCH CENTER TEACHERS COLLEGE, COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY, MAY 2013)

- Results (in 2013)
 - 25 states offer 11th grade assessments (not WA)
 - Examples: COMPASS, AccuPLACER, SAT, ACT
 - 8 states offer transition curricula
 - 21 states have “local” transition coursework efforts
 - Courses are offered in math (mostly) and English
- Transition Curricula: Special courses, set of modules, and/or online tutorials offered to at-risk 12th graders
 - Successful completion links with placement in credit bearing courses
 - Successful is defined in different ways
