Coaching	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • focus and intentional • builds trust with teachers • Full time coaching to provide both in and out of classroom support to staff (example LAB teacher to lead by example)
Behavior interventionist	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hire a full time Behavior Interventionist to provided one on one support for students • support staff to provide resources and training to reinforce classroom behavior
Community Outreach	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teaching parents to improve parenting skills • Providing strategies to parents for educational support • Parents partnering and volunteering during academic events • Intentional coordination with tribal structures including the courts and social systems

Unique Challenges of Education in Wellpinit

- Geographically and socially isolated
- 60% unemployment rate
- High poverty rates (94% qualify for free lunch and 3% qualify for reduced)
- 70% of students being raised by non-biological parent
- Social and emotional trauma
- Generational trauma
- High suicide rates (5 in the last 3 years)
- 80% of K-12 students qualify under Title III English Language Proficiency
- 70-80% of our kindergarteners are identified as intensive in the fall
- Drug and alcohol abuse
- Attendance issues
- Lack of intrinsic motivation
- Small pool of quality candidates that apply
