



## ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM COMPARISON CHARTS

### Policy Considerations

This memo features data on schools receiving supports and interventions in the accountability system. The data provides board members an opportunity to examine the performance of schools in Required Action District status.

### Accountability System Comparison Charts

These charts show a comparison of schools in the accountability system. Schools receiving interventions and supports through Priority or Required Action District status are improving at faster rate than the state average. Both the all students group and the targeted students group in Required Action District Cohort I made impressive gains over the three years during which those schools received intensive support.

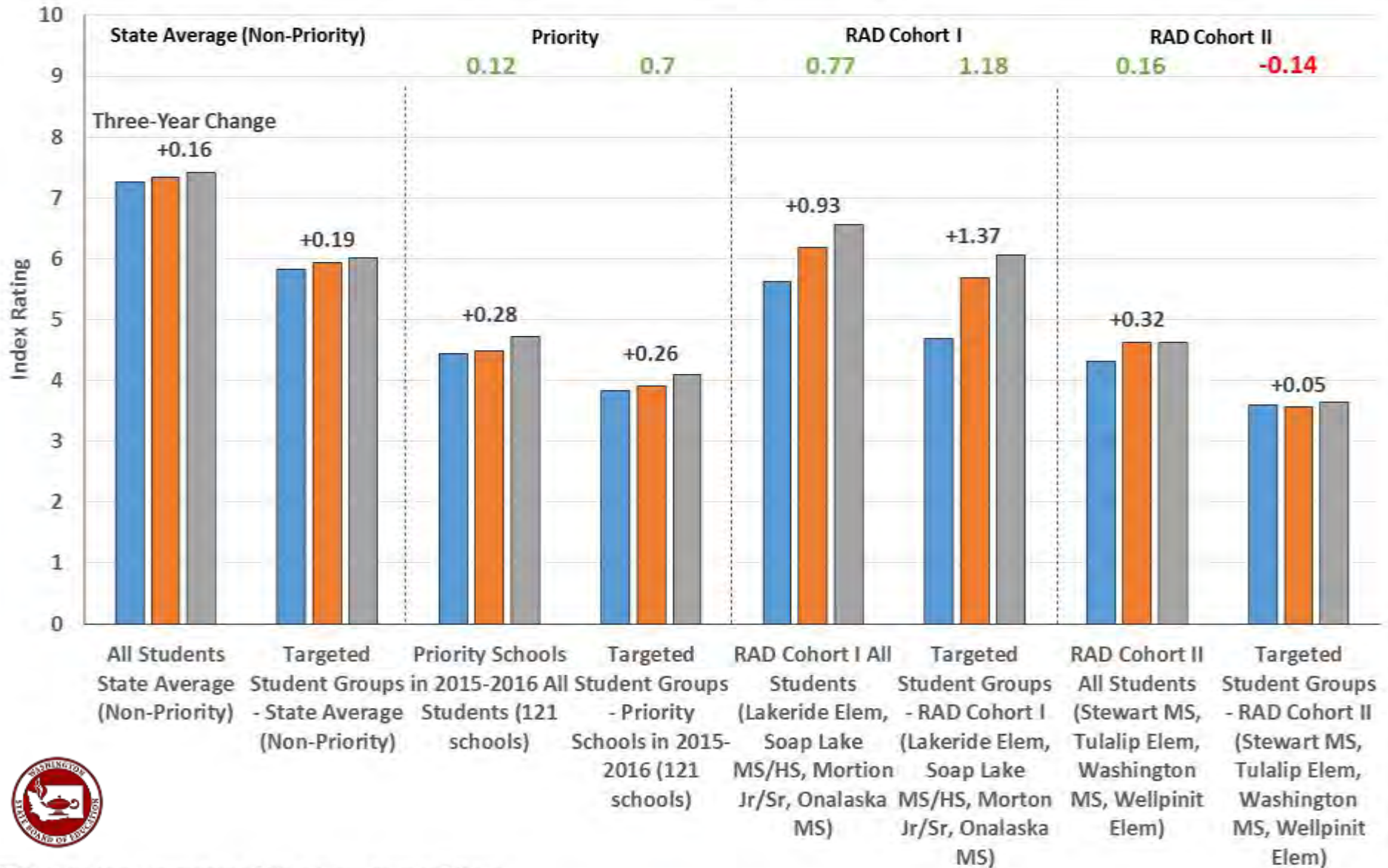
Please note that the 2014 Index ratings are based on assessments taken during the spring of the 2013-2014 school year. Thus, the Required Action District Cohort II school results show performance levels before those schools were receiving intensive support from the state.

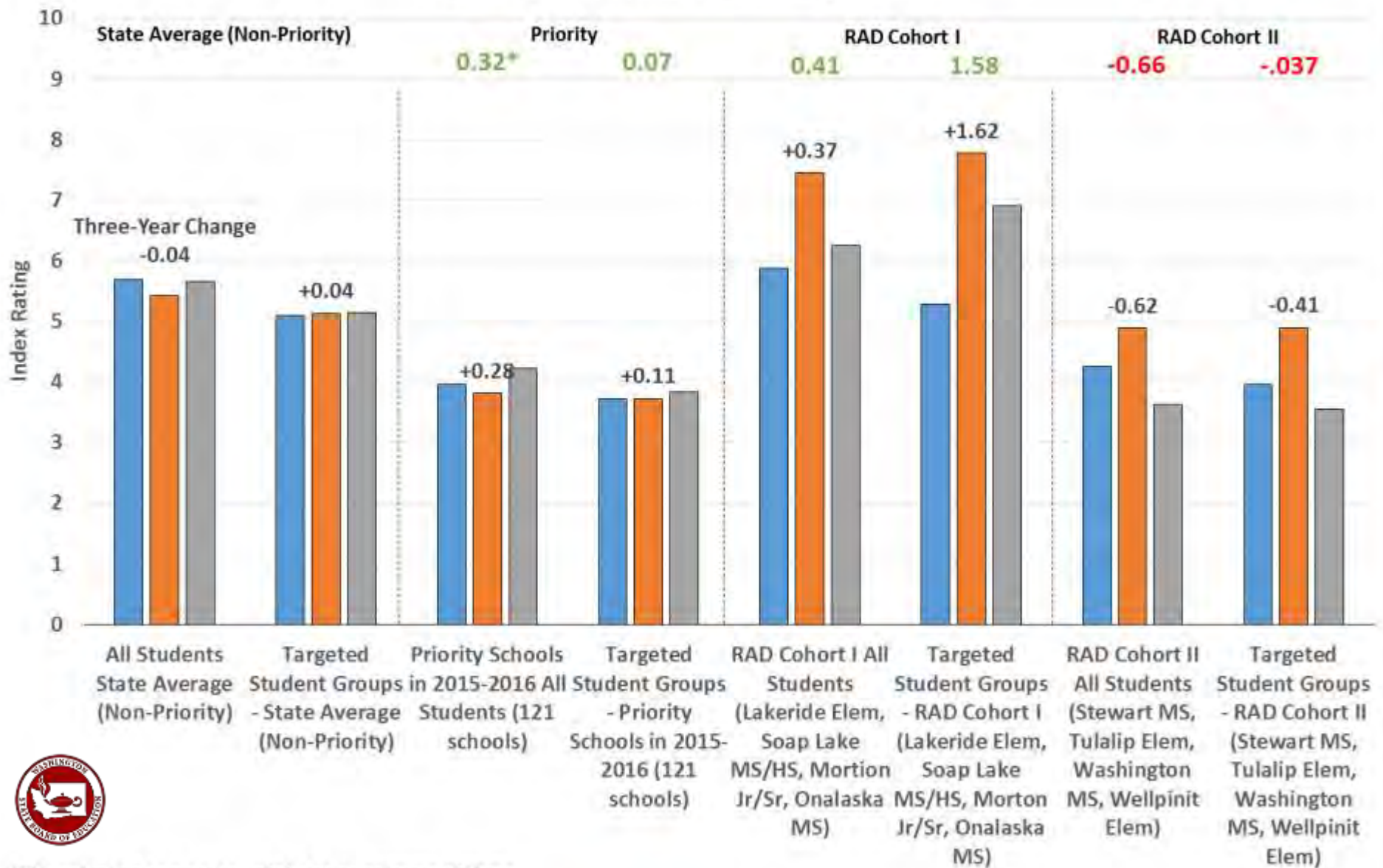
### Proficiency - Combined Reading, Math, Writing, and Science
