Graduation Requirements – Class of 2020

Credits

- 24 credits, some districts have waiver
- 17 credits "core"

HSBP

- Senior year resume/activity log
- FAFSA/WASFA information

Graduation Requirement: Credits

Consider:

- Credit via work completion
- Credit via competency-based assessments
- Core credits through course equivalency
- Two-for-one policy (CTE and core credit from same course)
- Pass/no-credit transcript designation



Credit Waiver Options

Non-Core 2 Credit Waiver

- Local policy
- Student circumstances
- Up to 2 credits

Emergency Rule: Waiver of Additional Credits

- On-track to graduate spring 2020
- Demonstrate "good faith effort"
- May include core or elective credit
- Expires July 31, 2020
