




BASIC EDUCATION COMPLIANCE DATA

This data is preliminary because 17 districts are still verifying their data for basic education compliance for the 2018-2019 school year. Member Estes contacted Parker Teed regarding whether considerable progress has been made on implementation of science and lab science credits. These preliminary data show that approximately three times as many districts require three credits of science and two credits of lab science for the Class of 2019 than for the Class of 2018. SBE staff will present on the basic education compliance data in January 2019 once all districts have verified that their data is correct.
